We also learned 3 sight words - make, play, day. Please practice all the words nightly so that they become automatic for your child. Remember there are 60 words all together. I will give you the rest of the word cards at conferences. Some kids are almost to the party zone!!

Don't forget, your child is expected to write 3 sentences! I think this will be our biggest challenge! Keep practicing writing sentences using high frequency words.

In math, we have begun adding using manipulatives or pictures. We will be adding and subtracting within 5.

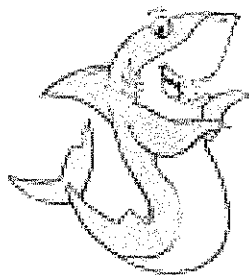
