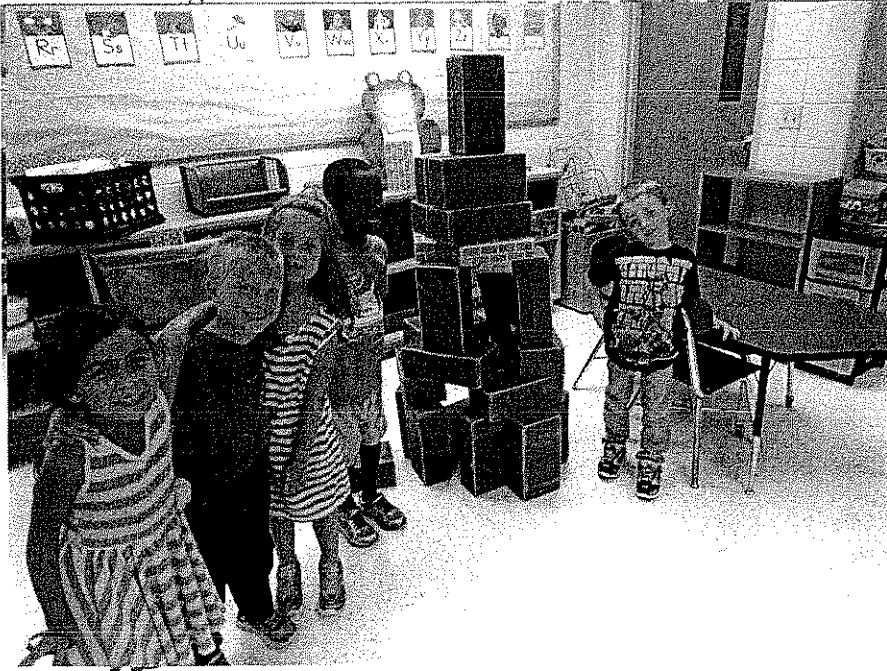


# Kinder Co-op News

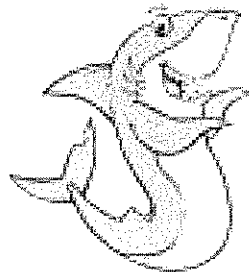
In math, we are doing a spotlight number each day. We learned about the number 0. We are also working on correctly writing the numbers 0-5
