We have been working hard on multi-digit multiplication. At home it would be very helpful for your child if he or she had a little extra practice. Please practice 1 digit by 2 digit, example: 2×53 . Then 1 digit by 3 digit, example: 4×384 and 2 digit by 2 digit, example: 46×97 . We have been using the area model to solve the problems. Look over your child's work from the "Wednesday Envelope" for examples. Thanks for the extra practice. Also, don't forget about the basic multiplication facts which are very important now that we are doing multi-digit!
