Summer School:

Summer school will be recommended for students that are below grade level in meeting the standards for reading and math, so they can obtain extra practice during the summer.

Summer school will go from 8-12:00 on June 20th to July 24th. There will be no summer school on July 4th. Please begin to plan for utilizing this free summer program, if you know your student could use the extra help. Stocker does have an on-site recreation department program that goes from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. daily in the summer. Talk to the school office if transportation will be an issue.

Kindergarten and Early Education Registration for the 2018-2019 school year:

If you need to register a child for kindergarten or prekindergarten, please mark your calendar. Stocker will begin registering students for 4K and Kindergarten on Feb. 21st. **It is very important that you bring the required documents with you to registration.** The paperwork includes: the child’s birth certificate/proof of age, immunization records and proof of residency. Children must be 5 years of age on or before Sept. 1st, 2018 to be eligible for Kindergarten. Children must be 4 years of age on or before Sept. 1st, 2018 to be eligible for Early Education. Please pass the word on to neighbors. Stocker will be better prepared to teach your children if you register early.

Forward Exam (Statewide assessment for 3rd-5th graders)

Starting on March 19th, the Forward Exam testing window will be open for our students to show how smart they are via the state test in reading and math. Fourth graders will additionally have to take the social studies and science portions of the test. Please feel free to contact your child’s teacher to find out the exact days your child will be doing their required sections of the assessment.

We hope that you can assist us in telling your child to do their best on each test and answer each question to the best of their ability. Help them to get enough sleep prior to the assessments and send in a healthy snack to refuel throughout the day.
